RECENT STATE OF FLORIDA GOVERNMENT ACTIONS

Expansion of Phase 1 | Executive Order <u>20-120</u> | Effective May 11, 2020, the Phase 1 recovery plan was expanded in three ways.

First, Palm Beach County was brought into the Phase 1 plan. Originally excluded by language that isolated much of Southeast Florida, the expansion pulls Palm Beach County out of those additional restrictions and places Palm Beach with most Florida counties. Miami-Dade and Broward counties remain under additional restrictions.

Second, the Order adds barbershops, cosmetology salons, and cosmetology specialty salons to the Phase 1 recovery plan. Those businesses can open in all counties except for Miami-Dade and Broward. Opening for those businesses requires following specific social distancing and precautionary measures put in place by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. Those specific precautions can be found <u>here</u>.

Finally, the Order extends EO 20-112. This is largely an administrative measure as EO's must be extended every 60 days if they are to remain in place. Since the Governor was taking action involving EO 20-112, he took the opportunity to extend along with those actions.
