**Governor's Re-Open Florida Task Force** | Governor's Re-Open Florida Task Force [documents](#) | Governor Ron DeSantis has created a task force of government and business leaders to help guide the state as it weighs the decision to reopen amid the COVID-19 outbreak. The task force includes a 22-member Executive Committee and three industry working groups. The working groups are:

- Industry Working Group on Agriculture, Finance, Government, Healthcare, Management and Professional Services
- Industry Working Group on Tourism, Construction, Real Estate, Recreation, Retail and Transportation
- Industry Working Group on Administrative, Education, Information & Technology, Manufacturing, Utilities and Wholesale

The Executive Committee and working groups have been meeting with the goal of jointly providing the Governor with recommendations on April 23, as he looks to re-open the state's economy in the short-term. The task force will then shift focus to considering recommendations for the medium- and long-term.

The recommendation discussions on short-term re-opening have two consistent themes: (1) prioritizing health and safety, and (2) quick, clear guidance businesses need to follow in order to re-open.
