Extension of State of Emergency | Executive Order <u>20-166</u> | Governor DeSantis has extended the declaration of a state of emergency due to COVID-19. Executive Order <u>20-52</u>, issued on March 9, 2020, as extended by Executive Order <u>20-114</u>, was set to expire on Tuesday, July 7, 2020. Under Executive Order 20-166, the state of emergency is extended for sixty days and will expire September 5, 2020. All Phase 2 Recovery measures put in effect by Executive Order <u>20-139</u> will remain in effect.
