

## RECENT STATE OF FLORIDA GOVERNMENT ACTIONS

**Vaccine Administration** | Executive Order [21-62](#) | Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order [21-62](#) regarding COVID-19 vaccine administration. Effective March 15, 2021, COVID-19 vaccinations in Florida will include persons aged 60 years of age or older. The populations that are eligible for a vaccine are as follows:

- Long-term care facility residents and staff;
- Persons 60 years of age and older;
- Health care personnel with direct patient contact;
- K-12 school employees 50 years of age and older;
- Sworn law enforcement officers 50 years of age and older; and
- Firefighters 50 years of age and older.

All individuals authorized to administer COVID-19 vaccinations may also vaccinate persons determined by a physician to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19. Such physician determinations shall include a statement that the patient meets the defined eligibility criteria established by a [form](#) prescribed by the Florida Department of Health.
