

Current List of Bills Filed for Consideration During 2020 Legislative Session

AD VALOREM

[HB 223](#) & [SB 514](#)

Prohibits a person or family unit claiming or receiving an ad valorem tax exemption or tax credit from another state from claiming homestead exemption under Sec. 196.031, Fla. Stat., unless the person or family unit demonstrates to the property appraiser (1) the person or family unit did not apply for the tax exemption/credit in the other state, and (2) the person or family relinquished the tax exemption/credit in the other state.

[SB 284](#)

Limits the amount a homestead property owned by persons aged 65 and older can be assessed for the purposes of school district levies subject to certain conditions. This bill is linked to the passage of [Senate Joint Resolution 282](#), which amends Art. VII, Sec. 4 and Art. XII of the Florida Constitution.

[SB 148](#) & [HB 371](#)

Revises the time frame during which the accrued benefit from specified limitation on homestead property tax assessments may be transferred from a prior homestead to a new homestead. Both the House and Senate Bills are linked to the passage of Joint Resolutions: [Senate Joint Resolution 146](#) and [House Joint Resolution 369](#).

[HJR 477](#)

Creates Sec. 20 of Art. VII of the Florida Constitution. Provides that a local government may not create a new local tax or increase a local tax unless the tax is approved by a two-thirds supermajority vote.
